ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
WITHDRAW GUILTY PLEA

[PROPOSED]

THIS MATTER comes before the Court upon Defendant’s motion to withdraw his guilty plea on the basis that he did not knowingly and voluntarily enter the plea because counsel failed to advise Defendant of the immigration consequences of his guilty plea, and Defendant therefore received ineffective assistance of counsel under the Sixth Amendment to the United States Constitution. See Padilla v. Kentucky, 559 U.S. 356, 130 S. Ct. 1473, 176 L. Ed. 2d 284 (2010); In re Personal Restraint of Tsai, 183 Wn.2d 91 (2015).

Having considered the entirety of the records and file herein, and the arguments of counsel, the Court hereby GRANTS this motion. The judgment and sentence previously entered in this case is vacated. The defendant is permitted to withdraw his guilty plea.
